

Foundation and Key Stage 1 Rewards and Sanctions

GOLDEN RULES

Children in Foundation and Key Stage 1 are expected to follow the Golden Rules which are discussed frequently and prominently displayed around school. KS1 have weekly assemblies during which a Golden rule is presented as a focus for the week. FS2 will address the same issue in circle time. SB will be responsible for the board which highlights these.

REWARDS

The smiley face system is in place in KS1 and FS2.

Hierarchy:

- 1) Verbal praise
- 2) Ticks, stars etc x 3
- 3) Smiley face
- 4) Certificates in KS assemblies
- 5) Certificates in Primary assemblies
- 6) Certificate at end of term for children who missed NO golden time

Other rewards include sending children to show work to another teacher, star of the day/ week, being given extra responsibilities etc.

SANCTIONS

The following hierarchy of sanctions was agreed:

- 1) A warning look
- 2) Verbal warning is given, reminding them of which rule they have broken
- 3) A warning card is issued- a sad face with the child's name on. This is put on a board in the classroom. If behaviour improves this may be withdrawn.
- 4) If poor behaviour continues, children are given time out. This is immediate in FS and in golden time in KS1. This will be recorded by the class teacher/assistant.
- 5) A sad face and an accompanying letter will be sent home to inform parents that their child has missed golden time.
