



French Teacher (Both Primary and Secondary)

Teaching MFL at BSA is at the same time really rewarding – *many of the children have a natural talent for languages* – and at the same time challenging – *some of our students arrive never having studied French before*.

The teacher appointed will be expected to teach both in the Primary and Secondary School up to a minimum of GCSE level. French is taught from Year 1 upwards and is also offered at A'level if there is demand. Our current French teacher is locally recruited and is willing to stay on, on a part-time basis, if required.

All our departments are reasonably well resourced and all departments have their own budget. Funds may be available for staff if they have any particular development plans.

French is a highly valued subject with our parents, with many of them speaking French themselves. The opportunity to teach small, motivated classes is what is available to the teacher appointed and for Secondary trained teachers it also offers the opportunity to extend your experience into Primary.

The secondary department is currently looking at ways in which a more cross curricula approach can be introduced to elements of Key Stage 3 and an interest in being involved in this would be welcomed.
